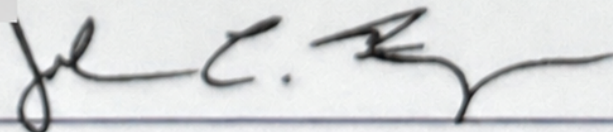

NRA Instructor Responsibility and Expiration

Official certification requirements relevant to the identification card

- **Three-year term.** NRA Law Enforcement Firearm Instructor certification and recertification are valid for three years from the date of issuance.
- **Continuing education.** Recertification requires proof of at least 24 hours of qualifying in-person firearms or instructor-development education completed during the expiring three-year period.
- **Expiration.** After expiration, the NRA provides a 12-month grace period for recertification through its continuing-education option. Longer lapses trigger additional reactivation requirements.
- **Membership responsibility.** Active NRA membership is required. If membership lapses during the certification term, the instructor certification is suspended until membership is restored in good standing.
- **Agency responsibility.** When the instructor works for a private law enforcement agency, the employer must also maintain the required NRA Agency Enrollment.
